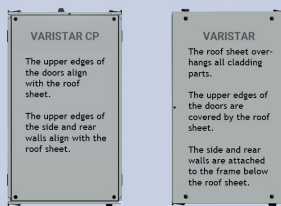


Varistar und Varistar CP – What is the difference?

The roof of Varistar CP does not protrude



The door of Varistar CP collides less with the cabinet base and the cabinet top.

Varistar CP is always offered with leveling feet because the door is set lower.

The doors of Varistar CP are more stable and available with various locking options



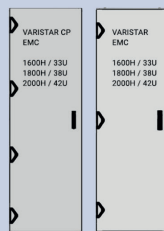
The IP55 and EMC handles can now also accommodate KABA and ASSA locks, which was not possible in the previous Varistar range.

Externally, the handles look identical.

Handle with 1333 lock is standard on front and rear doors.

The key for the 1333 lock features the Schroff logo.

Varistar CP EMC doors are more robust for larger cabinet dimensions

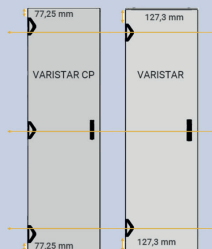


Varistar CP EMC doors feature larger dimensions and have multiple locking points and hinges.

4-point locking and 4 hinges for
1600H / 38U 1800H / 42U 2000H / 47U

Varistar CP IP55 doors only differ visually from Varistar in the position of the hinges.

The doors of Varistar CP are more stable



For cabinets with 38 or more rack units (HE), Varistar CP IP20 cabinets feature 3 hinges instead of the 2 hinges found in Varistar IP20 cabinets.

The upper and lower hinges are now positioned closer to the outer edge.

Cabinets with 25 to 33 rack units still have 2 hinges.
